*** Explanation of Embark/Debar Restrictions Codes:**

Captain's Choice & Other Remote Ports (Note 1): In the 2010 itinerary, we have a number of days listed as Captain's Choice. On these days the vessel will likely visit ports/destinations which are either very remote, difficult to plan ahead for and/or subject to local weather conditions. We have identified these days (ports of call) and all Residents and Guest are NOT allowed to embark or disembark in these ports. Those ports are identified in the 2010 Itinerary Calendar the column labeled "Emb/Deb Restrict." as "1" to indicate that there is a restriction and that no one will be allowed to embark or disembark in this port.

Other Restrictions (Note 2): In an effort to contain our port costs due to incremental stewarding costs and/or governmental immigration issues associated with clearance, we have restricted the embarkation and disembarkation of all passenger traffic on select days. For ports with early morning departures (i.e., before 9 AM) where there are significant port fees related to boarding, we will restrict all passengers (Residents and Guests) from embarking or disembarking on those days. These restricted ports are also identified in the 2010 Itinerary Calendar under the column labeled "Emb/Deb Restrict." as "2".

Tender Schedule (Note 3): For port calls at anchor, please do not book flights prior to 12:00 hrs to allow for the ship's tender to take you ashore with sufficient time to then proceed to the airport. The ship's standard operating procedure for tenders is to begin operations at 7:30 hrs.
